

Timeline to Starting Your Degree

Enrollment may take several weeks to several months, starting when you confirm your eligibility for the **Discount Tire Education Program** and ending when you enroll in online courses at Arizona State University. To speed up the process, complete your application and submit required materials as quickly as possible.



Day 1

Visit **DiscountTire.Instride.com**.

Know which degree you want?

Click *Get Started* to confirm your eligibility and select your degree program of interest. Don't worry - you can switch later if you change your mind.

Not sure which degree you want?

Explore your options at **DiscountTire.Instride.com**.

Submit your information for programs that interest you and an ASU enrollment coach will contact you to help you decide.

Days 2-13

Connect with your ASU enrollment coach. They'll call you or you can call them directly at 844-353-7953.

At the same time, you can begin the application process:

- Consult with your ASU enrollment coach to ensure that your degree is a good fit and understand course scheduling.
- **2.** Submit your ASU Online application and pay the application fee.
- **3.** Request your transcripts from previous institutions.
- Complete your FAFSA and Financial Aid file. While this is not required, it is highly recommended.

Days 14-29

Ensure all required application materials have been submitted to ASU. You can track your application status and progress on your My ASU page.

Your application will not be considered complete until all official transcripts are submitted and you have paid the \$70 ASU application fee. Days 30-50
